Day 1 : Brussels – A Capital Affair.

There could be no better introduction to Europe than Brussels, capital of Belgium, and headquarters of the French and Flemish communities. From a 10th century fortress town to the de facto capital of the European Union, Brussels is also home to NATO, the Western European Union and EUROCONTROL.

A cosmopolitan city of a myriad diverse cultures, Brussels is lively, vibrant and truly a city lying at the crossroads of Europe. Here you will stroll across picturesque medieval streets, rest in lively squares, be surrounded by beautiful boulevards, marvel at impressive monuments, gambol in spacious parks, chit-chat in cosy cafés and dine in interesting restaurants.. You will visit the renowned Grand Palace, gaze at the legendary Manneken Pis Statue, halt at St. Michael's Church, witness the Palace of Justice and be mesmerized by the Atomium.

Day 2 : Amsterdam – A Bridge Too Far.

No visit to Europe can be complete without experiencing the Venice of the North, Amsterdam. Historically one of the most important ports of the world, Amsterdam is a city of fascinating architecture and picturesque landscapes, criss-crossed with canals running through unique canal houses, an idyllic city on the banks of the serene river Amstel.

Here you will revel in the fragrance of the world's largest tulip garden, Keukenhof , where Daffodils, Hyacinths, and narcissi rub shoulders with delicate orchids, flaming azaleas and hydrangeas. You will understand the finer nuances of the sublime art of making wooden shoes at Ratterman's wooden shoe factory, not to mention shop to your hearts content for souvenirs. You will gaze at windmills, negotiate a historic canal or two in a sleek glass-topped boat, and leave this wonderful city of a 1000 bridges with as many memories to match.

Day 3 : Cologne and Heidelberg – A Whiff Of History.

With 2000 years of glorious history behind it, Germany's oldest city Cologne is, as you will discover, also one of its most beautiful. Dwarfed by the Cologne Cathedral, whose spires at 515 feet tower over this vibrant, uncomplicated city, here you will find innumerable cultural and historical treasures, world famous museums and an active art scene.

You will then undertake a cruise along the salubrious banks of the incredibly romantic River Rhine, that traverses four countries. You will view the legendary Lorelei Rock,

gaze at medieval castles atop riverside cliffs, get a whiff of intoxicating vineyards and pass lazy towns with picture-book houses.

The best, of course, will be still to come. Heidelberg, the jewel of the Neckar, a quaint city of charming streets, ancient buildings and modern thinking. A classic university town, Heidelberg has much to offer, like the Heidelberg Castle, perched majestically atop the Königstuhl mountains and leisurely walks through the 'Alstadt', the old town of narrow alleys and cobble-stoned streets.

At the end of yet another fulfilling day, you will spend a relaxing night at a fine hotel in Mannheim.

Day 4 : Innsbruck – Crystal clear.

Straight out of Grimm's fairy tales, Innsbruck, or "the bridge over the Inn", is a city rich in culture and heritage, reflected in the grand Gothic facades of its innumerable monuments. The journey by road to this historic city traverses some of the most picturesque Bavarian Countryside in Europe, which is probably one of the reasons, along with its much vaunted tradition of hospitality, that makes Bavaria one of the most visited states in Germany.

Here you will be introduced to the fascinating world of crystals at the world-famous **Swarovski Crystal Museum** at Wattens, a glittering experience that also offers you the opportunity to pick up a souvenir for your family.

You will spend the night in the salubrious climes of Austria.

Day 5 : Venice – Life's A Boat.

When your destination is so gorgeous, can the journey be far behind? Travelling to the "**Bel Paese**" or beautiful country through the **Brenner pass**, a mountainous pass through the Alps, 59 miles long and 4,497 ft high, allows you to encounter some 22 tunnels and 60 large bridges, while you gaze upon pastoral Europe below, high Alpine pastures used by dairy cattle for summer grazing, an idyllic sight, like no other you would have ever seen.

We make our way towards an archipelago of 118 islands, 170 canals and about 400 bridges towards Venice, the Queen of the Adriatic.

Venice, a romantic city of crossed canals, poetry and passion, welcomes you with open arms. A boat ride to St. Marks square, the very heart of Venice, and we are face-to-face with the **Bridge of Sighs** - the last view of Venice that convicts saw before their imprisonment. Then, from the **Doges palace**, the **Ducal (Duke's) residence**, we move on to the St. Mark's Basilica, a monument made unique by both its wealth of history and the magnificence of its façade and interiors through the centuries by great European artists.

After a halt at the **St Mark's Clock-tower** to see the most important clock in the city, our tour culminates at the **Murano Glass** factory where master craftsman demonstrate the art of creating the famous **Venetian blown glass**.

We spend a comforting night in Venice.

Day 6 : Rome - Cradle of Europe.

Our Italian sojourn continues as we head to Rome, home of some of the most celebrated architectural and artistic masterpieces of the ancient world. Our journey is through the **Po Valley** which separates Alpine Italy from the **Apennine Mountain Range** stretching 1000 km from the north to the south of Italy along its east coast, traversing the entire peninsula. Forming its geologic backbone, the Apennines stretch almost the entire length of Italy. The drive takes us across the fascinating Po Valley, Italy's richest agricultural region, through the important Renaissance region, and further through the famous wine villages.

Arrive, explore, absorb Rome. You have the rest of the day to do so.

Day 7 : Rome – The Eternal City.

Rome is divine, not the least because it houses the **Vatican**, centre of the Catholic church and the smallest country in the world at forty four hectares, and a population of around 900 only.

Take in the Vatican Museum and visit the famed **Sistine Chapel**, a pure source of inspiration for artists and tourists alike, specially included on your tour. The extraordinary works of Michelangelo have made the Sistine Chapel one of the most famous art galleries in the western world. Visit **St. Peter's Church**, adorned with architectural and artistic masterpieces by Michelangelo and Bernini, which houses the **Pieta**, the only work of Michelangelo ever signed by him.

Be humbled by the sheer size of the **Colosseum**, an imposing 2000 year-old stone structure with a vast amphitheatre where gladiators in ancient Rome vied for their lives. See the **Victor Emmanuel Monument** built to honour the first king of unified Italy, the **Venice Square or the St Mark's Square**. Visit the **Caesar's Forum**, a section of the **Forum Romanum**, built by Julius Caesar in 46 BC.

Say goodbye to Rome with a visit to the **Trevi Fountain**, where it is that if you turn your back to the fountain and toss a coin inside anything you wish for comes true.

Spend the night at a hotel in Rome.

Day 8 : Florence - Birth-place of the Renaissance.

Our appetite whetted, we continue our Italian journey northwards, heading to Florence, of 'Florence Nightingale' fame. Birth-place of the Renaissance, Florence has a lot to offer, like the **Duomo, the Campanile, the Baptistry** with its Gates to Paradise, **Piazza Della Signoria** - an open-air museum of sculptures, **Pallazio Vechio**, the **Uffizzi Art Gallery**, and the **Ponte Vecchio - bridge** across the river Arno. Drive to **Piazzale Michelangelo**, a square on top of a hill with its replica of the impressive **statue of David**. On the south bank of the Arno River, just east of the center of Florence, the place offers a fantastic view of the city.

Finally, we head towards the Pisa, where we first stop at the **"field of Miracles"** and view the grand Romanesque Pisan styled **Marble Cathedral** and last but not the least, the Baptistry and Bell Tower, better known as the **"Leaning tower of Pisa"**.

We spend the night in Florence.

Day 9 : Switzerland – Playground of Europe.

No journey to Europe can be complete without a visit to Bollywood's very own backyard, Switzerland. The Swiss Alps beckon invitingly, a stunning landscape of undulating snow-capped peaks, lush meandering meadows, limpid lakes and medieval cities. While you take in the scenery in the drive of a lifetime, you begin to understand why these locales inspired generations of Bollywood stars to fall in love.

Spend the evening exploring Switzerland. Rest assured, you too will fall in love.

Day 10: Switzerland - The Titlis Rotair.

Nothing quite prepares you for the snow and ice experience on the highest viewpoint in Central Switzerland, the 10,000 ft.Mt.Titlis. The 45 minute ride up in the world's first revolving cablecar, the Rotair, is an unforgettable experience, as you traverse from lush green meadows to scenic lakes to snow clad mountains before the hour is through. Discover that the majestic Alps looks even more bewitching from the sun terrace. Ride the Ice Flyer across Mt. Titlis, or take a snow tube down a 500-ft slide. Hungry for more? A delicious hot vegetarian lunch in the cold Swiss mountains awaits you.

You will return from the mountains, only to go back in time in the city tour of Lucerne, where you will visit the Lion Monument and stroll across the 14th century Kappel Brucke wooden bridge over the river Reuss. Or indulge in leisurely walks along the banks of Lake Lucerne, soak in the ambience in the charming streets of the old town, or just pick up quaint curios from the numerous little shops dotting it.

For a perfect end to an exciting day, spend the night cradled by the Alps.

Day 11: Switzerland - Jungfrauoch and Interlaken.

Some of you may choose to spend this day at leisure, exploring the salubrious climes of Switzerland on your own.

For the more adventurous, the only way to go is up. To the top of Europe, to visit the memorable Jungfrauoch. Along the way, get mesmerized by the view from the 'Cog-Wheel' train, as it undertakes a unique journey through scenic alpine countryside, climbing to a height of 3,454 meters to reach Jungfrauoch. Rated amongst the top 10 train journeys in the world, this unique experience comes to a grand finale with a freshly cooked Indian Vegetarian Lunch at the Bollywood theme restaurant.

Located between Lake Brienz and Lake Thun, at 570 metres above sea level, lies Interlaken, our next halt. One of the world's most popular resorts, situated at the foot of the Jungfrau, Interlaken is a haven for adventure seekers, flush with skydiving, canyoning, hang gliding, paragliding and skiing facilities, to name a few.

Spend another night in Switzerland, before you head to France.

Day 12 : Paris - Sip by sip.

The romance of Europe comes alive more than ever before in the redolent mustard fields of France, only to get accentuated as you glide through the Burgundy region, with a little help from their favourite produce – the world's most celebrated wines. Day 13: Paris - From Disney to dance.

Today is kiddies day out. Disneyland Paris, here we come. Mickey Mouse, Donald Duck, Cinderella vie for your kids' attention, not to mention yours.

The evening, however, has an entirely different story to tell, for those who decide to venture out from the comforts of the hotel. As night falls, Le Lido, the legendary cabaret and burlesque house on the Champs-Élysées comes into its own with an exotic and unforgettable display that may well be the highlight of your evening in Paris.

Le Lido is an exhilarating evening of dance and music that slowly unfolds in a mesmeric display of light and sound, and fills your senses from the core. For best results, sipping on a complimentary glass of champagne is strongly recommended, to help you truly appreciate the nuances of the bohemian spirit of Paris.

Some will say, however, that the most memorable part of a visit to Le Lido is in getting there. The sight of the stunning edifices around the Champs-Élysées lit up in all their glory makes 'Paris by night' a vision that will flash before you long after the lights have dimmed.

Yet another night in Paris. Soak it all in.

Day 14: Paris – City Of Dreams.

Stand atop the third level of the Eiffel Tower and watch the world's most romantic city unfold before your eyes. Visit the sights and sounds that make Paris what it is, like the Alexander Bridge, the Arc-de-Triomphe, Concord Square, the Opera House, the Invalides and the Champs-de-Élysées.

Gently float past a treasure-house of historical monuments on a memorable cruise down the River Seine. Make your way to the busy Gare Du Nord station to board one of the world's fastest trains, the Eurostar, which ducks under the English Channel to whisk you to London in less than 3 hours flat.

The evening in London is yours to explore. So is the night.

Day 15: London – Wax Eloquent.

Shoot the breeze at any of the numerous cafes and wine bars dotting the banks of the picturesque river Thames. Day 16 : London – Flight of Fancy.

Spend your last morning in Europe to do some last minute shopping if you are so inclined, or just relive and luxuriate in the memories of the days gone by.

Embark on an exhilarating flight of fancy atop the famous London Eye or the millennium wheel, the world's largest observation wheel. Discover an enchanting bird's eye view of London in a 30 minute flight 443 feet above the Thames. Soar over some of London's most famous streets, churches, palaces and monuments, in a unique experience you are never likely to forget.

With a heavy heart take your leave of London, and Europe, as you fly back to familiar territory, knowing in your heart of hearts that, sooner rather than later, you will return.
